PREPARE YOUR NOTES

If you expect to teach remotely, look at the curriculum in advance and prepare lessons at least for the first module.

Therefore, break your content into modules and sub-topics



CHOOSE HOW WILL YOU TEACH?

You could choose to record yourself teaching on a blackboard, if you have one at home. Or you could teach through presentations, or online whiteboards.



START RECORDING VIDEOS

Set up a comfortable, well-lit area and designate it for recording. You could use your mobile phone's or laptop's camera to record yourself.

Alternatively, you can just choose to record your screen which has the PPT.



CHOOSE A PLATFORM

You will need to manage all your students at one place on a platform where they can see your videos.

Choose a free platform like YouTube or a 14-day free trial of Podia to do so.



CREATE ONLINE QUIZZES

Check in on your students' learning progress through online methods.

Prepare short quizzes and tests to do so. Upload them on Google Forms or on Podia with your videos.



LAUNCH & REACH-OUT

Upload all your videos, quizzes, handouts onto the platform of your choice. Publish your course and send out an email to all your students and prospects.
